A BILL

Making continuing appropriations for veterans benefits in
the event of a Government shutdown.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR VETERANS**
4 **COMPENSATION, PENSION BENEFITS, AND**
5 **EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE.**

6 There are hereby appropriated for fiscal year 2014,
7 out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appro-
8 priated, for any period during which interim or full-year
9 appropriations for fiscal year 2014 are not in effect, such

1 sums as are necessary, at a rate for operations as provided
2 in the applicable appropriations Acts for fiscal year 2013
3 and under the authority and conditions provided in such
4 Acts, to administer and furnish the compensation, pension
5 benefits, readjustment benefits, veterans insurance and in-
6 demnities, veterans housing benefits, and vocational reha-
7 bilitation benefits provided for under title 38, United
8 States Code.

9 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION.**

10 Appropriations and funds made available and author-
11 ity granted pursuant to this Act shall be available until
12 whichever of the following first occurs:

13 (1) The enactment into law of an appropriation
14 (including a continuing appropriation) for any pur-
15 pose for which amounts are made available in sec-
16 tion 1.

17 (2) The enactment into law of the applicable
18 regular or continuing appropriations resolution or
19 other Act without any appropriation for such pur-
20 pose.

21 (3) January 1, 2015.
